## TENSE TALKS

This year's events continue to keep a busy pace, even in August, which is usually a time for relaxation in most countries.

Following renewed tests of military equipment, the UN adopted further [sanctions](#) on 5 August, on the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, introducing a full ban on coal, iron and iron ore, prohibiting port calls by designated vessels, chartering of DPRK flagged vessels, and exporting of seafood.

On the same day, in Manila, the ASEAN Foreign Ministers met, commemorating the organization's 50 years, and in their [joint communiqué](#) reaffirmed the need to enhance mutual trust and confidence in the South China Sea. The 10 ASEAN Foreign Ministers were joined by all ASEAN dialogue partners, including the Foreign Ministers from Japan, both Koreas, China, India, Russia, Australia, USA, Canada, and the EU. This gave much-needed opportunities to exchange views, although no major decisions were taken. The dialogue is expected to continue in November, at the ASEAN Summits in Manila and APEC Summit in Da Nang, Vietnam, which also the US President has [committed to attend](#).

Asia is a very diverse region, and countries have understandably diverging views of how to shape the best future for themselves and the region. An interesting compilation of visions for the [future infrastructure of Asia](#) was made by the Washington-based Center for Strategic and International Studies. The various visions outlined by these maps underscore the importance of continued dialogue.
